What we wrote

Textbook for the first maths course in Finnish upper secondary school (students are ~16 years old).

A4 PDF for the ease of copying, modifying, printing, distributing, ...

Tools we used: Github & LaTeX



Things escalated a bit...

- We started an organisation
- We did the booksprint again after a month
- So far we've had more than ten booksprints!
- "Book donations" have been pouring in!
